

MACON

The 2009 vintage

This is the sixth year in Biodynamic viticulture.

Following a classic winter, spring was sunny and warm.
The vines grew rapidly, with the first flowers noted on 26 May.

Despite poor weather from 5-16 June, July was very fine, with a heavy rainy spell at mid-month.

August had excellent warm weather, with rapid grape ripening.

In September, the grapes were healthy and of good quality; harvesting began on 12 September under very good conditions.

Alcoholic fermentation finished quickly, with malolactic fermentation starting at the end of the winter and finishing during the spring.

The wine is rich, powerful and well balanced, with lots of liveliness and mineral notes, the whole enveloped by fine, subtle floral and citrus aromas.
